- 1. At least one assembled, layered and guilted block—more if you choose
- 2. Binding strip measuring 1 1/4" high and approximately 44" long (the width of a bolt of fabric)
- 3. A needle you are comfortable sewing with (betweens are preferred), thread, scissors, ruler, and pencil
- 4. A permanent ink marker
- 5. If you prefer to find your own fallen hero to honor, please bring print outs of information about him/her that contain the following: name, rank, branch of service, date of death, hometown of record and state; as well as biographical information.
