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Kite and Crown Block

The Kite and Crown block is also called the Rose Star Hexagon block and is sweeping the quilt world. It can be English-paper pieced, but Marti will show you how to rotary cut and machine piece this beautiful block in a fraction of the time.

While it can be cut entirely with the 60° kite shape, Marti will show how and when to substitute the crown shape for two kites. See other blocks and one-patch designs using the same shapes. Learn several ways to join the blocks. This is a fabulous carry-along project; class sewing can be done with regular hand-piecing or machine piecing.

Fabrics:

8 - 10 coordinating fabrics (approx. 18 x 22 inches) with a variety of value and scale.

Other Supplies:

Acrylic templates will be provided for use in class.

Favorite personal sewing notions, thread scissors, seam ripper, etc.

Small folding mirror set (optional) - samples will be available in class.
