FEBRUARY MYSTERY QUILT INSTALLMENT BORDER UNITS

1. Using the remaining 4-½" x 2-½" light rectangles and the remaining 2-½" squares, make **96** pointies. First, press the squares in half diagonally. Place on one end of the rectangle and sew along the pressed line and press open. *Take care to place each 2-½" square on the same end of each rectangle.*
2. Pair up the rectangles, long edges together. Flip the top rectangle left to right and sew together. You will make **48** border blocks.
3. Refer to the photo below for clarification.
