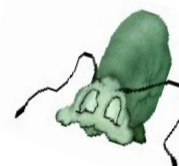

February Meeting: The master quilter, teacher and designer, **Sue Bouchard** will present her extensive and wonderful trunk show. Sue spent 27 years working and traveling with Eleanor Burns, and we are so very lucky that she has retired to live in Fallbrook where she enriches quilters in our area by teaching at the Quilters Cottage and presenting to our guild. Get ready to be impressed with her quilts.

February Workshop: Sue Bouchard will cover straight binding, French, accent, back to front, infinity and techniques on how to change the color of the binding to enhance the design of the front of your quilt. Each one offers a different design option for the perfect finish to your quilt.

March workshop: The Big Bag Workshop will be at bargain price and presented by our own Deb Raver. If you are tired of struggling to bring your bed sized quilt or materials to a meeting, workshop, or friendship group, this big bag is the answer. It is made of 32 six inch blocks or whole cloth. Participants will need to have the 4 x 8 block rectangular (approximately 24" x 48") shape already quilted before coming to the workshop. You will finish the project that day!
