Quilt Show News

It seems like a long way off but before we know it, the quilt show will be here! It won't be long until you'll start seeing publicity about the show.

For those new to the guild, our show is a two-day show the first full weekend in November in odd-numbered years. This year the dates are November 8-9, 2019. We set up on Thursday, November 7.

The show is not a "judged" show, meaning that the main purpose is to let the community see what we do. Everyone is encouraged to enter at least one quilted/crafted item, and everyone is expected to help on some committee or other.

Start to think about the places you would be willing to help out and be ready to get your entry forms filled out with 2" scraps of the main fabrics used in the quilt, along with a color photo, a sketch or some other representation of the quilt.

You can also donate some of your gently used, no longer needed items for the Country Store, and the Auction is always looking for a few good quilts!

On the guild website, on the Quilt Show page, is information about the show, including the list of committees to see where we need help, and the entry form, to print off for each item entered. Quilts are not collected until near the end of October, so even if the quilt is not finished, please fill out the entry form.

More information will be provided in future newsletters, so keep your eyes peeled for updates! Help from everyone is needed!

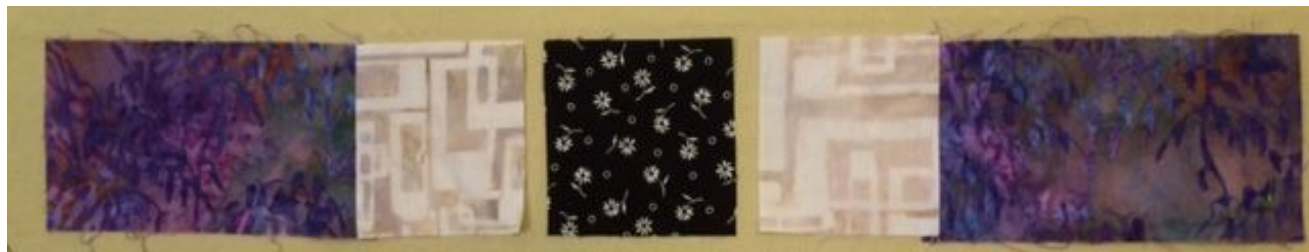

JANUARY MYSTERY QUILT INSTALLMENT

Bringing It All Together, Part 2

1. If you haven't already done so, sew a 2 ½" light square to one end of a tone-on-tone rectangle. Make eighteen.
2. Sew a dark 2 ½" square between two units, being mindful of placement. Refer to photo, below:



3. Place this strip between two matching/coordinating units from November using the photo below for reference. Take care to keep the dark corners and light sections to the outside of the block. Make nine blocks:



That's it until February!
