QUILT COLLECTION INSTRUCTIONS

Linda Musillami and Tina Rainey will be collecting all the quilts for the quilt show.

There are two days that you can drop off your quilts to us:

TUESDAY, October 31, from 3:00 pm to 6:00 pm - and

WEDNESDAY, November 1, from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm

Drop off location: Linda Musillami's house 1744 Via Entrada, Fallbrook, CA (865) 924-7033

Requirements:

1. Make sure your sleeve (instructions on webpage under 'Quilt Shows') is sewn on the top of quilt.
 - a) If you have a large quilt, divide the sleeve so there is an opening in the middle (for loops)
 - b) Fold your quilt so the BACK RIGHT is at the top of the folded quilt.
2. If your quilt is King-sized, make sure it is pinned/basted UP to 95"
3. Clean your quilt (wash or put in dryer, etc.) so it is free from animal hair.
4. You will receive a receipt for all the quilts you enter. Receipt MUST be presented to collect your quilt on Saturday.
5. Please call Tina (760) 223-2560 or Linda (865) 924-7033 if you have to make special plans for delivery of your quilt.
6. ALL quilts need to be tagged for placement in the show. If you need to deliver the quilt directly to the church, you MUST come to Linda's for the bags, tags, and receipts for your quilts.

FALLBROOK QUILT GUILD EXECUTIVE BOARD MEETING MINUTES October 13, 2017 at the Quilter's Cottage

The meeting was called to order at 10:06 am by Barb Vajda, President. Participants: Barb Vajda, Sandy Scott, Marie Sundsboe, Collette Ford, Betsy Shirkey, Tina Rainey, Dixie Johns, and Renee Toomey

Old Business: Barb Vajda reported items for the newsletter should be in Diane Trappen's hands by Oct 17 or 18. Barb asked if there had been any feedback about moving Show & Tell up in the agenda and the timing of the meeting. The only suggestions were to start the meeting at 6:00 pm promptly and try to have the meeting end no later than 8:30 pm.

New Business: Treasurer's Report: Betsy Shirkey reported income to date of \$699.00, Expenses of \$1,231.34, and a bank balance of \$20,756.42 including the \$100 in the Paypal account.

Membership Update: Tina Rainey reported attendance at the October 5th meeting was 68, with 60 members and 8 guests from the El Camino Quilt Guild. The verified total of members is 83. Barb Vajda mentioned members were concerned about having new member's addresses and other info included in our newsletter each month. After discussion, it was decided to have Tina Rainey email a separate sheet with the personal information to Diane Trappen who will, in turn, include that sheet as a separate attachment to her email blast of the newsletter.

Ways and Means: Dixie Johns reported we have a record number of items for the Country Store. She needs more people to sign up to man the Opportunity Quilt Table to sell tickets. This is a "sit down" job.

Quilt Show 2017: Sandy Scott says she still needs volunteers for set up and take down. She plans on paying some younger people who can climb ladders to help out. She plans on offering \$15 - \$20 an hour for this help.

Renee Toomey reminded everyone she will be having knee replacement surgery on October 30th so she will be out of commission until the first of the year. October 5, 2017

The meeting was called to order at 6:42 pm by Barb Vajda, President. Barb led the Pledge of Allegiance, welcomed our guests, visitors, and members. The October 2017 Board meeting will be held on October 13, 2017 at the Quilter's Cottage at 10 am. Barb welcomed Carol Macalooso of the North County Quilt Guild of Escondido who brought their Opportunity Quilt to the meeting. Please support them by buying tickets.

Newsletter Deadline: The deadline for items to go in the guild newsletter is October 15th. Any items should be sent to our new newsletter editor, Diane Trappen at QuiltDLT@aol.com.

Treasurer's Report: Betsy Shirkey reported our income was \$1,079.00, expenses \$2,148.92, leaving a balance of \$21,188.76.

Membership Report: Tina Rainey reported we have 68 attendees, 60 members and 8 guests. Total membership as of now is 83, including exempt members. Note the membership number was confirmed this month as there was some confusion the prior month.

Quilt Show Update: Sandy Scott reported she now has 199 quilts for the show so far and she expects the number to rise. Sandy still has jobs open for the quilt show. Please sign up for at least one job. Betsy Shirkey announced we have over 100 items, including 6 baskets donated for the auction at this time as well as a vintage Singer sewing machine which will be offered as a Silent Auction item.

Sylvia Williams announced items for the Country Store can be dropped off at the meeting, dropped off with Mara Woods, Paula Manning, or Sylvia, or one of them will pick up if necessary.

Tina Rainey announced quilts should be dropped off at Linda Musillami's home on October 30th and November 1st. Time information will be included in the October newsletter. Credit card payment will be accepted for admission, the boutique and the auction. The café will be cash only.

2016-2017 Opportunity Quilt. Carol Carpenter and Ardis Duhachek were kind enough to volunteer to take our quilt to the San Diego Quilt Show. She said the quilt was admired by many and they sold \$218 worth of tickets at the show. The Opportunity Quilt and some of the Country Store items will be present at the Fallbrook Harvest Festival on October 15th.

Show and Tell: Many members brought in their projects to show to the group. Barb moved Show and Tell up in the program to make sure members could see the work being done by our group.

Speaker: Sylvia Williams introduced Terry Waldron who presented "The Art of Doing It All". Terry highly recommends members create a web page for their quilt quilt creations as she has been surprised by some of the people/organizations who bought her quilts.

Drawings: The drawings were held after Terry Waldron's presentation

The meeting was adjourned at 9:05 pm.
