Spinning Stars Tabletopper

This wonderful Tabletopper is so much fun to make! You can use a controlled palette of color by using 2 fabrics for the stars, or you can 'scrap-it-up' like the Sample. Using strip-piecing techniques, you will have this Tablerunner done in no time! You will also learn a terrific assembly method plus lots of other tricks and tips from Debbie to use in all of your quiltmaking.

Fabrics

All fabrics should be first quality, 100% cotton, [I prefer pre-washing prior to use] Please choose any colors you would like. The color notations listed below are simply for you to identify where in the 'Sample' the colors appear.

Background – 1/2 yard

Fabric for Stars - choose from Scrappy or Controlled...

For Scrappy Stars:

4 ½" x 5" scraps of 21 reds [OR 7 each of 3 reds or the Equivalent] 4 ½" x 5" scraps of 21 greens [OR 7 each of 3 greens or the Equivalent

OR

For Controlled Palette Stars:

½ yard Red

½ yard Green

Not needed in class:

*Backing - 1 yard

Supplies

Rotary mat, 18 x 24 works best for this project

Rotary ruler, 6 x 12 Omnigrid or Equivalent

Rotary cutter with new blade

Sewing Machine in good working order that you are familiar with

100% cotton sewing thread, neutral color

2 pre-wound bobbins

Small scissors to clip threads

Straight pins and holder

Fabric appropriate markers in a variety of colors: ie: white, silver and mechanical pencil

Seam ripper

Basic Sewing supplies
