

“WHERE’S MY LLAMA?” SUPPLY LIST

Finished size is approximately 26”x23”

BACKGROUND: When completed, this should give the appearance of a stone pathway with light mortar between each stone.

One dark grey/mottled black/charcoal fat quarter

One medium dark grey/brown/tan fat quarter. Attach Wonder Under to the back of this fabric only.

LLAMA: A variety of light neutrals such as off-white, cream, ecru, beige, tan, etc. Small prints and tone-on-tones work best. Please bring at least ten 1 ½” strips, enough to swap.

FACE, EARS AND FUR: Two additional light neutral sections, 18” x 22”. They should be different from each other.

NECK PIECE: 5”square, any stripe or chevron print.

WONDER UNDER ½ yard.

BORDERS:

Inner border – 8” by width of fabric, any contrast. The sample is red.

Outer border – two options. #1 – ¾” yard, any stripe. **OR** #2 – Any other non-directional fabric, ½ yard.

NOSE AND EYES: 1”x 5” section black.

THREAD: off-white, red and medium brown – a close match to medium background fabric.)

OPTIONAL: Red embroidery floss for tassels. Small applique iron.

BASIC SEWING SUPPLIES: Sewing machine, scissors, thread snips, mat and rotary cutter. Plus anything else that would make your sewing experience more pleasurable.
