## FEBRUARY MYSTERY QUILT INSTALLMENT

## BORDER UNITS

1. Using the remaining $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ light rectangles and the remaining $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares, make 96 pointies. First, press the squares in half diagonally. Place on one end the rectangle and sew along the pressed line and press open. Take care to place each $2 \frac{1}{2}$ "square on the same end of each rectangle.
2. Pair up the rectangles, long edges together. Flip the top rectangle left to right and sew together. You will make 48 border blocks.
3. Refer to the photo below for clarification.
