July 2014 Block of the Month


Out of Any Red, White and Blue Fabric:

1. Cut (4) 2.5 " red squares
2. Cut (4) 2.5 " white squares
3. Lay one red square on on white square RST (right sides together)
4. Sew $1 / 4$ " on two sides (pivot, or sew separate seams, but you are making a point)
5. Snip top of corner seam
6. Turn right sides out
7. Press flat with inside seam 'changing direction' at the point
8. Repeat steps 3-7 three more times

You now have 4 'pinwheels'
9. Cut (4) 4.5 " blue squares

10 Pin one pinwheel edge to edge on one blue square
11. Repeat step 10 three more times.
12. Sew the squares together to form the pinwheel.

Red and white 'points' should be able to move up and down in the seam allowance.
Finished block should measure $8.5^{\prime \prime}$ edge to edge
Happy Sewing.
