

Center Pinwheel 9" Finished



Cutting Instructions Using Three Fabrics

Fabric A-Background & Pinwheel	Fabric B- Pinwheel	Fabric C- Squares
3 1/2" Square Cut 2	3 1/2" Square Cut 2	2 3/4" Square Cut 4
2 3/4" x 5" Rectangle Cut 4		

1. **Half Square Triangle (HST) Units:** Make four.

- Place one 3 1/2" Fabric A square & one 3 1/2" Fabric B square right sides together. *Fig.1*
- Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner. *Fig.2*
- Sew 1/4" away from the drawn line on both sides of the line. *Fig.3*
- Cut the square in half on the diagonal line. *Fig.4*
- Open and press towards Fabric B. Trim to 2 3/4" square. *Fig.5*

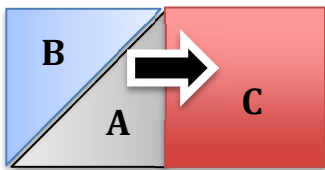

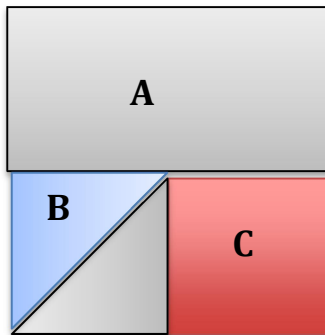

2. **Sewing the block. Refer to the diagrams.**



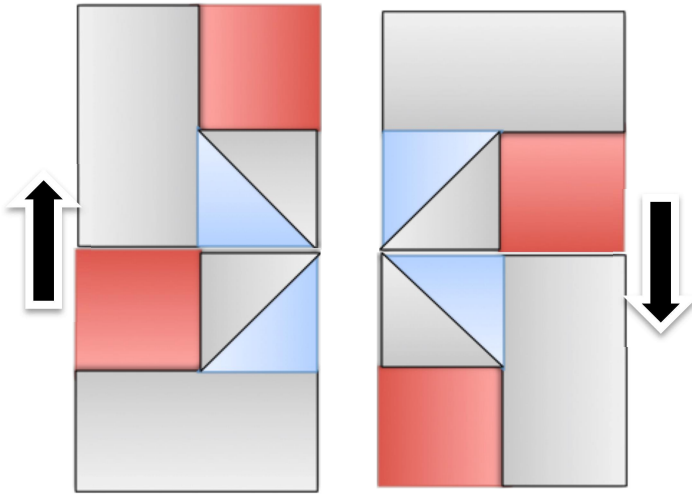
- Sew one HST to one Fabric C 2 3/4" Square.
- Press towards Fabric C Square
- Measures 2 3/4" x 5."
- Make 4.



Add one Fabric A rectangle.
Press towards HST unit.
Measures 5" x 5".
Make 4.

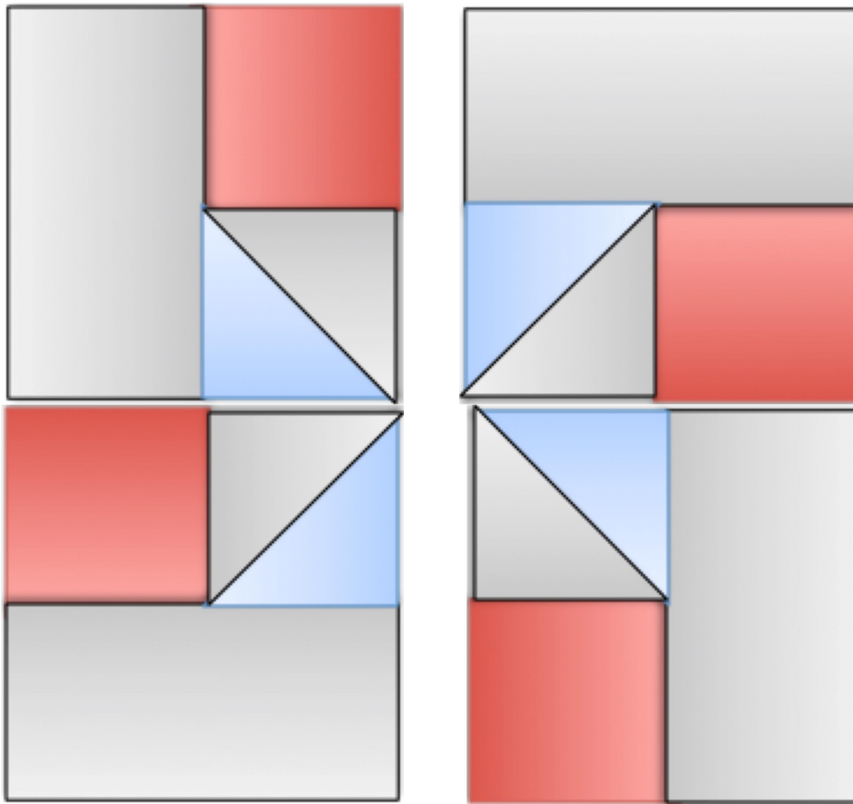


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- Arrange the units as shown and sew together.
- Press towards arrows.

3. **Constructions:** Sew the two sections together to complete the block. Press seam open. To “spin your seam flat,” see websites listed below. The Center Pinwheel block should measure 9 ½” unfinished.
