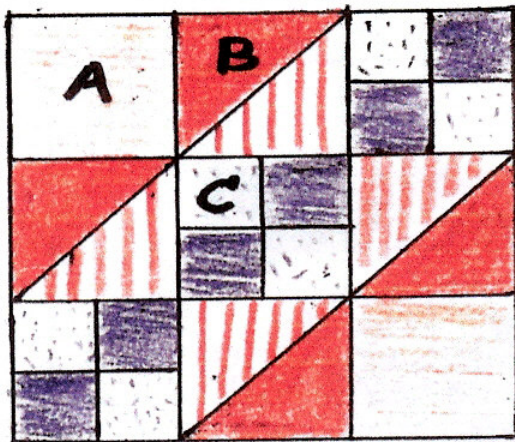

Road to the White House 12"

Cutting: from cream C cut 6
 blue C cut 6
 from red stripe B cut 2
 solid red B cut 2
 from beige A cut 2

A \square $4\frac{1}{2}$ " B \square $4\frac{7}{8}$ " C \square $2\frac{1}{2}$ "

Piecing instructions :

- 1.) Referring to the piecing diagram to piece one block, join 2 cream and 2 blue squares (C) to make a four-patch unit; repeat for 3 units.
- 2.) Sew a red stripe to a solid red triangle (B) along the diagonal to make a side unit; repeat for 4 side units.
- 3.) Arrange the pieced units in rows with 2 beige squares (A) referring to the piecing diagram. Join units in rows; join rows to complete one block.
