Hard to believe Spring is right around the corner. But we're hoping these floral Asian fabrics will bring a smile to your cold quilting days. I created this pattern, although I am sure someone has probably published it somewhere already. I wanted to keep it as uncomplicated as possible, but still fun.

<p>Step 1. Sew the 3 inch square to the 1 ½ inch strip and press. Make a total of two</p>		<p>Step 2. Sew a 3 inch square to the opposite side and press. Make a total of two.</p>	
<p>Step 3. Sew a 6 ½ strip as shown: one in the middle and the remaining two on the top and bottom. Press after sewing each strip in place</p>		<p>Step 4. Sew an 8 ½ inch strip to each side of the block and press. This illustration only shows one because my scanner is not large enough. Sew an 8 ½ inch strip on both sides.</p>
