September Program: Joy-Lily's "How to be a Carefree Quilter"

Our monthly meeting is September 8 and our speaker is Joy-Lily from San Francisco who will teach us "How to be a Carefree Quilter". Please note the September meeting is a week later than usual due to Labor Day weekend and the San Diego Quilt Show.

September Workshop: "Lazy Leaves Table Runner"

Joy-Lily's workshop on September 10 is making a Lazy Leaves table runner. Please sign up and pay the registration fee of \$35 to hold your place. The class is filling up.

October Program: Thom Atkins "Trunk Show"

Thom Atkins, an award winning quilt artist from Santa Cruz, will be joining us October 6 to share his trunk show of quilts and how he makes them.

October Workshop: "Bead Embroidery for Quilters"

Thom Atkins' workshop is Saturday, **October 8 on Bead Embroidery for Quilters**. This class is an over-view of beads (and buttons) and their use on quilted surfaces. The techniques covered in this class will enable the students to actually quilt a piece with the application of beads (and buttons) so that they are an integral part of the quilt, not just surface adornment. This is a class about process and the students should not expect to go home at the end of the day with a finished piece but rather a road map for future work with beads on quilted surfaces. We still have a few seats available in the workshop---so sign up soon to reserve your space. Registration is \$35 and the kit fee payable to Thom in the class is \$25.

Enchanted Hexagon Garden

2016 - 2017



Sales are under way for this year's Opportunity Quilt, Enchanted Hexagon Garden, 79" X 94.5". This spectacular quilt has already been on its first "quilt run" and was shown at two shops, our very own beloved Quilter's Cottage and also at fabulous Fat Quarters in Vista. We are very lucky and honored that these shops allowed us to participate in their quilt run. Be sure to thank them the next time you are shopping in these stores so they know that they are appreciated. Thanks should also be extended to our members who volunteered, on short notice, to sell tickets for us over four days of the run. We sold 352 tickets for a total of \$307.

Many thanks for those of you who have already received and paid for your \$25 packet of opportunity tickets. At our July meeting, we hit the one-third mark of members receiving their tickets. According to our by-laws, everyone is required to sell one packet of tickets. We are hoping that you will sell MANY MORE!! If you have not yet picked up your tickets, or, if you are ready to sell even more tickets, they will be available at our next meeting in front of our fabulous opportunity quilt, Enchanted Hexagon Garden.

Did you know that there is a "mini" version of the Enchanted Hexagon Garden quilt that will be won by the member who sells the most tickets? Yes. And, this could be YOU! You will receive credit for ticket sales when you sell YOUR tickets and you will also receive credit when you sell tickets at venues and events. The more hours you volunteer to sell tickets, the more credit you will earn.

Our next venue to sell tickets will be on August 12 at Fallbrook's 'Wine and a Bite' event. After passing around a sign-up sheet at our last guild meeting, we have enough wonderful volunteers covering the sales at this event. THANK YOU!

We do need more people to sign up for the San Diego Quilt Show, Sept. 1 - Sept. 3, and at Road to California, Jan. 19 - 22. If you are planning to attend either of these events, it would be so appreciated if you could sign up for a shift at the Opportunity Table. WE NEED YOUR HELP! The sale of these tickets funds our programs/speakers etc. Please, grab a friend to join you and sign up together to help out.

To recap, there are many ways for you to help with the sale of tickets this year. First, be sure to pick up your packet of tickets. Sell these tickets, or, buy them yourself! When you run out of tickets, get some more to sell! Second, sign up to sell tickets. We need lots of volunteers for this job. Thank you in advance for volunteering your precious time.

As you are helping our guild pay for our up-coming speakers and programs by participating in ticket sales for this year's opportunity quilt, here are some "selling points" you may wish to share about our Enchanted Hexagon Garden Quilt:

- ⇒ it is all hand-pieced using English paper piecing technique
- ⇒ it is hand-appliqued
- ⇒ it is hand-quilted
- ⇒ there are 111 hexagonal flowers in the main body and 27 hexagons in each flower
- ⇒ it took 1000+ hours of work to make (FYI: minimum wage is currently \$10.50/hour, to be raised to \$11.50 in January of 2017 = \$10,500 to \$11,500 in labor costs alone for the construction of this quilt. WOW.)

- 2015-2016 financial audit was conducted on 6/24/16. All records were accounted for and in compliance.
- All members that have renewed and paid dues by the end of the meeting were entered into a raffle for a free workshop. The winner of the raffle was Linda Flynn.
- All members are reminded to pick up and pay for their raffle tickets for the 2016-2017 Opportunity Quilt.
- Clarification to board meeting minutes published in newsletter: There is no workshop in November but there is a speaker, Lyn Mann, at the monthly general meeting.

Minutes of Fallbrook Quilt Guild Executive Board/Committee Chair Meeting

July 8, 2016

Call to Order: An Executive Board/Committee Chair Meeting of the Fallbrook Quilt Guild (FQG) was held at 942 Morro Road, in Fallbrook, California. The meeting was convened at 6:06 by President Shirley Fleming who presided. Other members present were Marie Sundsboe, Diana Rash, Barbara Vajda, Sandy Scott, Louise Cobb, and Kathy McKernan.

Committee Reports:

Treasurer's Report (Barbara Vajda): June income was \$202.00 and expenses were \$1353.62. Current balance is \$31,029.10. For the 2015-2016 fiscal year actual income was \$36,068.12; expenses were \$22,034.77. The audit for the 2015-2016 was completed successfully on June 24, 2016 with no issues found. Barbara has deposited \$3,612.10 from monies received to date for 2016-2017 fiscal year. Compliance Officer detected an issue with adherence to process of a committee chair handling money. Committee chairs and members handling guild money will receive emailed reminder as well as follow up verbal reminder.

Membership (Diana Rash): Fifty-three members were in attendance at the July 7, 2016 Fallbrook Quilt Guild meeting with no guests or new members. Fifty-two persons have renewed their membership to date. Nineteen members are on auto-renew. The final deadline for members to renew and have their contact information appear in the 2016-2017 directory is the August meeting. Members are required to fill out the Membership Application of Renewal Form. All checks must be made out to "Fallbrook Quilt Guild" and not "FQG." There will be a New Member Orientation Tea for new members who have joined the guild over the last 3 years at Ardis' house on July 11 from 1-2:30 P.M. Seventeen were invited with 8 new members confirming attendance.

Ways and Means: Sales for the 2016-2017 Opportunity Quilt were brisk at the July Guild meeting. It is expected that additional raffle tickets will need to be printed. Ways and Means is making arrangements to show the 2016-2017 Opportunity Quilt throughout the year. A spot at the 2017 Avocado Festival was secured and will be shared with the Boutique on the 3rd Sunday in April. They have asked for assistance with the two upcoming events: the Fallbrook Wine and Bite Festival in August and the San Diego Quilt Show in September. The Opportunity Quilt team will also sell raffle tickets at the Fallbrook Fall Faire Oct 16 in a booth shared with the Boutique.

Newsletter (Collette Ford): Deadline for content was discussed to ensure that print copy of newsletter will be received prior to month Guild meeting. No firm decision was made. It was recommended that Collette receive final content by the 15th of each month.

Programs 2016-2017 (Lou Cobb) Programs for 2016-2017 are already under contract and the cost will be within the \$10,000 budget allocated last year. Since we have had feedback that guild members would like more speakers and speaker's schedules are usually booked at least 12 months in advance, it was suggested that the Board consider a larger budget for the 2017-2018 year. Although, that budget won't be officially created until next year, we need to give Sylvia a target budget number this year so she can contract speakers for the following year. The board agreed to consider an increased number for Sylvia to use in her planning.

Directory, Website and Quilt Show (Sandy Scott): Sandy reports that she is still working to find another site to hold the show. Board members requested that reimbursement form be made available on the website.

Budget: After much discussion a proposed budget could not be finalized due to lack of input from board and committee chairs. An emergency meeting will be held on July 14.

Next Executive Board meeting: Due to information missing needed to pass the 2016-2017 budget, an emergency meeting will be held Thursday, July 14 at 942 Morro Road.
