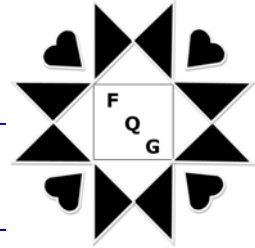

Turtle Camp Sewing Needs

The Turtle Camp provides a week of camp for campers, and sometimes their families, with a wide variety of illnesses. *They send each child home with a turtle pillow and a small quilt.* In 2012 the Lake Elizabeth fire burned a large part of the camp.

The Santa Clarita Valley Quilt Guild has been working with them to replace quilts and turtles. Our community service team called the camp to check on what was most needed. They said the *turtles!*

The fire destroyed all but 400 turtles which had already been stuffed. The plastic tubs where the unstuffed turtles were stored melted. That is their biggest need.

They are willing to provide the pattern and fabric. The camp is always in need of twin bed quilts for the beds at the camp as they are washed and reused until they fall apart!
