Minutes of Fallbrook Quilt Guild/ Committee Chair Executive Board

Call to order: An Executive Board/Committee Chair Meeting of the F.Q.G. was held at the Quilter's Cottage, in Fallbrook CA. The meeting was convened at 10:00 a.m. Presiding was 1st Vice President, Anne Turley. Members present were: Anne Turley, Marie Sundsboe, Diana Rash, Linda Musillami, Shirley Fleming, Sandy Scott, Ardis Duhachek and Sylvia Williams.

Items discussed:

2012-2013 Opportunity Quilt: The prior year Ways and Means committee has completed their assignment and the new Ways and Means committee would like to go ahead with sales for the 2014-2015 quilt. The board discussed the potential for the 2012-2013 opportunity quilt "Flowers of the Night" to earn more raffle sales prior to the raffle date of Thursday August 7, 2014. A permit for this raffle date has been issued. To date 2,900 tickets have been turned in. The decision was made to END sale of raffle tickets for the "Flowers of the Night" quilt despite its relatively short sales window. Any outstanding raffle tickets should be given to Sandy Scott. Sandy Scott will house the 2012-2013 quilt including the stand, roll-along, binder, jar and mini-quilt until the raffle. Motion and unanimous vote to cancel the scheduled showing of the 2012-2013 quilt at the El Camino Quilt Guild meeting on July 10, 2014.

2014-2015 Opportunity Quilt: The 2014-2015 quilt raffle ticket sales will begin once the tickets are printed. The drawing for the 2014-2015 opportunity quilt will be in June 2015. Application for raffle date will be submitted by Sharon Baker. Ways and Means committee are planning on showing this quilt during the August Hot Summer Nights and Fall Festival.

Transition of Board/Committee Chairs: All Board and Committee Chair transitions have been completed or are in process.

Directory: Directory will go to the printer by the end of August. Guild members with dues paid by the August meeting will be included. The directory should be available for members at the September meeting.

Hospitality: Need additional volunteers for the July meeting. Only three signed up at the last meeting.

There were additional sign-ups today at the meeting.

UFOs: Idea discussed for general membership meeting. Members who wish to participate would bring in 5 UFOs. Projects will be randomly numbered from 1 through 5 at the meeting. Members will have 2 months to complete a project, starting with the project designated #1. Every other meeting, members will show their UFOs and receive a ticket (Snip-It).

Bank Signatures: Reminder to go to Western Pacific Bank to sign the bank card if you are a signer.

You need to sign a card every year even if you already did last year.

Tax I.D. #: Community Center/Senior Center requires number for rental. Table for next meeting.
