Meeting opened 1:04

Members present – Frannie Marr, Tricia Voight, Ann Turley, Karen Johnston, Linda Rosensteel, Barb Anderson, Penny Bottomly, guest Jan Conklin.

Next meeting April 13 will be at Barb Andersons, 1:00, 1388 Las Vistas

Ann Turley made a motion to approve the minutes of the last meeting, seconded by Linda Rosensteel, minutes were approved.

Frannie announced new officers will be installed at the June Guild meeting and take office as of July 1, 2022

Reports

<u>Programs</u>: Ann Turley, Karen will be taking the April meeting. It will be a member sharing of tips, tools and techniques. The Saturday workshop will be making Quilts of Love. Dixie Johns is organizing this. May will feature Wendy Knight Art quilter. Her workshop Saturday will be instruction on making an art quilt featuring a horse. She will provide kits for \$25.

June will be the installation meeting, with a pot-luck. Tina Rainey will be asked to do the installation. To keep costs to a minimum, it was suggested that each table could be responsible for the table ware and decorations.

Karen reported there will be a conflict in August due to the Long Beach Quilt Festival. Therefore, she suggested that the Saturday workshop be cancelled.

<u>Treasurer's Report</u>: Barb Anderson reported \$700 income this month and several checks were sent out. There is approximately a \$33,000 balance. Jan reported on the process for submitting money to treasurer. Any funds being delivered to the treasurer should complete an Income submission form. Try to provide it to treasurer in a timely fashion in order that it can be deposited within the same month.

<u>Ways and Means:</u> Hemet Show did not make as much made as expected, \$50. However, Book Sales at the last meeting netted \$80. Books will be available at next meeting. \$73 in Opportunity Quilt tickets were sold at Valley Quilters Guild March meeting.

<u>Membership</u>: Linda Rosensteel reported 86 members at this time with one returning member and two members requesting to be removed.

The upcoming survey was then reviewed by members making suggestions and corrections for the final questionnaire. Discussion included improved money-making activities at the Guild meeting.

An announcement was made that we have been invited to display art quilts at the Fallbrook Library in May. Quilts need to be 16X20 inches and turned in by April 15. Interested quilters are invited, contact Ann Turley for more information.

It was also stated that the Bylaws should be included in the next Guild Handbook. This concluded the meeting.

Ann Turley made a motion to close seconded by Linda Rosensteel, the meeting was adjourned at 2:55pm.
