

Your Guild offers classes for the low price of \$30 plus any material fees paid to instructors. We provide quality instruction for a great VALUE!

In September you have the opportunity to take an Introduction to Needle Felting class from Phyllis Binkley. Phyllis is an accomplished art quilter. Known for her beautiful felted landscape art quilts, she was recently Artist in Residence at Asimalor. Please take a look at her website: landscapeartquilts.com.

Class fee \$30 members, \$40 non-members

Materials fee of \$20 covers: Wool base fabric, one for a landscape and one for a flower, 9X12 inches

All the wool roving and yarns to be felted into the pieces

Stabilizer to iron onto the back of the pieces

A variety of other fabrics to create different textures and reflections



Students need to purchase a Clover hand felting tool and sponge. Bring pins and scissors. If you have an Embellishing Machine, bring it along.

Thank you all for the kind words and encouragement as I undertake the honor of being your president. Please do not hesitate to bring your thoughts and ideas to my attention.

I hope to see many of you at the meeting on September 5, 2013 as we have quite a few important issues to discuss. Here are a few items, please be ready to discuss them at the September meeting.

- The 2013-2014 Budget approval
- The Board recommends that the "general rule" that the outgoing President shall receive a "life membership" be discontinued for future presidents, including the current president. Not to affect previous presidents prior to 2013-2014.
- Include in bylaws that membership dues are non-refundable.
- Guild Chair Excursion Coordinator status?

Our request for non-profit status has been accepted by the State of California. We have been notified that they will make a decision within 90 days.

The Executive Board is unable fund the scholarship for one of the recent applicants because she failed to meet the condition of enrollment for the 2013-2014 school year. We understand this was a disappointment to the recipient; however, it is imperative that the Fallbrook Quilt Guild's actions are consistent with its bylaws and past practices.


