Supply List

Quilted Big Bag Tote Workshop

Fallbrook Quilt Guild March 2020

- 1. Quilted piece of fabric at least 24.5" x 48.5" with the back side ½" longer on the 48.5" sides(pieced 6" blocks work well, or any blocks whose size is a multiple of 4" or 6" to achieve the 24.5" and 48.5")
- 2. 1.5 yards of fabric; some of this you will already have used for the back side of your quilted 24.5" \times 48.5" piece and the rest will be used for the pocket, handles (two 4 ½" \times 30" pieces of fabric) and facing 3 ½" \times 50". Note-you may use a different material/fabric than the lining for handles.
- 3. Batting for handles (may need more than one layer depending on what type of batting)
- 4. Basic Sewing Supplies
 - Sewing machine
 - Thread to match fabric
 - Batting for handles
 - Wound bobbin some of which will need to match your handles and the top of the bag
 - Scissors
 - Pins
 - Cutting mat,
 - Rotary cutter with sharp blade
 - Ruler
 - Seam ripper for unsewing possibility.
