

Frog Table Topper Fabrics:

Please liberally starch and iron all fabrics before class.

- four 10" squares (or equivalent) coordinating fabrics for bodies.
- four approx. 7" squares accent fabrics for bellies
- 3/8 yard contrasting fabric for block backgrounds and runner accent strips.
- 7/8 yard coordinating fabric for runner borders and center.

Also: Fusible web and micron pen or textile markers to create eyes; threads for piecing and quilting

Fancy Feathers Table Topper Fabrics:

Please liberally starch and iron all fabrics before class.

- **fat eighths** (or approx. 9" x 12" pieces) of **three coordinating batiks** for heads, bellies & wings
(this will create four identical birds.)
- **small pieces of coordinating fabrics** for crests
- **1/2 yard background fabric** for bird blocks and center strips.
- **1/4 yard stripe** (or graphic) for runner center and border
- **two 3/4" strips accent fabric** for thin borders
- **1/8 yard coordinating print** for wide border
- **four 1 1/2" squares of yellow** for beaks

Also: Small buttons for eyes; #8 pearl cotton in two colors for bird and feather details; embroidery needle for pearl cotton; threads for piecing; fusible web or other supplies for preferred method of appliqué. (Freezer paper and starch will be demo'd.)

IN ADDITION:

- **your sewing machine** with all cords, owner's manual and a 1/4" foot
- **basic sewing and quilting tools**
- **threads for piecing**
- **fabric glue pen:** Bohin or Sewline brands (any glue color) **OR a SCOTCH brand repositionable glue stick**
(Not a regular glue stick or glue-baste product)
- **8" square ruler**
- **removable fabric marking pen**
- **rotating cutting mat** (nice to have, but not required)
- **Small iron and ironing surface for your station** (if convenient)
