

Mini Poppins Bag  
Supply List  
Class date: 9/7/24

I am attaching the supply list for the Mini Poppins bag for the Saturday Quilt Guild Class. It would be great if everyone could have their fabric pieces cut and ready to sew.

I will have kits with the double sided fusible foam ( In-R-Foam Plus) and craftex plus pieces already cut for purchase or you are welcome to purchase your own at a quilt shop and cut them before class.

FABRIC:

- Main fabric (outside bag body, sashing) 3/8 yd  
(if using directional print fabric, you will need enough fabric to cut the following)

Cut 1 strip 10 ½" tall X WOF  
From this strip  
Cut: 2 rectangles 10 ½" tall X 16" wide  
2 strips 10 ½" tall X 1 ¼" wide

- Inside: (bag body lining and pockets) 5/8 yd

Cut 1 strip 10 ½" tall X WOF  
From this strip cut:  
Cut: 2 rectangles 10 ½" tall X 16" wide  
2 strips 10 ½" tall X 2" wide ( fold sashing strips in half lengthwise, right sides out and iron)

- Coordinating Fabric: 1/2 yd

(Binding for bag body and pockets)

Cut 3 strips 2 ½ " X WOF Fold each in half, lengthwise, wrong sides together and iron.

(Bottom Binding)

Cut 2 strips 1 ¼" X WOF ( do not fold and iron)

(Bottom, handles, zipper tabs, bows)

Cut 1 strip 8" X WOF

From this:

For the bottom cut 2 rectangles 8" X 10"

For the handles cut 4 strips 2" X 15"

For the zipper tabs cut 2 strips 2" X 4"

For the bows cut 2 strips 2 ½" X 6"

- Interfacing:

Double sided fusible foam

For the bag body: cut 2 10 ½" tall X 16" wide

For the handles: cut 2 strips 2" X 15"

For the zipper tabs cut 2 strips 1 ½" X 3"

Craftex plus:

For the bottom cut 2 rectangles 7" X 9"

You will also need:

- Pattern w/stays (I have a limited number of patterns available for purchase and several extra pairs of stays available for purchase)
- 30" handbag zipper with double slides  
(I have zipper tape by the yard in lots of colors and some fun zipper pulls available for purchase if interested)
- Thread to match all fabrics and hand sewing thread for the bag bottom
- Sewing supplies: Sewing Machine in good working order, walking foot (optional), sewing machine needles, scissors, pins, wonder clips, rotary mat and cutter, acrylic rulers, chalk or marking pens, seam ripper, hand sewing needle
